

Shakopee Heritage Society
Board Meeting Minutes
July 16, 2015

The meeting was called to order by President Joe Collins at 6:33 p.m. Members present were Lois Wendt, Pat Ploumen, Melissa Whiting, Don Wagner, Don McNeil and Wes Reinke. The secretary's and treasurer's reports were read and approved. We have \$8629.70 in the bank.

Joe will contact Bruce Loney and see what happens to Shakopee street signs when they are replaced. Maybe we can sell some of our signs.

We will take down our library display after this meeting so another group can use the display case.

We will sell our SHS T-shirts at Derby Days for \$8. The book prices will remain the same as last year. Melissa will e-mail the sign-up sheet for working the booth on Sat. Aug. 1.

If the tour of the Coller house doesn't work out, we may visit the Joseph Brown museum in Henderson. There are other places to check out there as well.
